

Home Reading




- *Reading taught within English lessons.

Homework




Homework is set to support current learning and fundamental skills, such as:

MyMaths



Please encourage your child to access MyMaths. It is a great way to learn new topics, as well as consolidating prior knowledge. At least one homework task will be set weekly and there is an expectation that all children complete this

- set Monday, close Monday morning.





Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

- *By the end of Year 4 children are expected to know their Multiplication Tables up to 12x12.
- *Online test which children will sit in a two week period, in the summer term. It consists of 15 questions, with 6 seconds to answer each.
- *It is important that children can recall them accurately and quickly.
- *Daily tables practice in school, with support from teachers.
- *Practise at home using TT Rockstars Soundcheck
