## Editing symbols used by teachers for marking writing.

E1	<b>REVISE</b> – find and correct spelling, punctuation and grammar errors.
E2	<b>REWRITE</b> – rewrite the sentences shown by  on an editing flap.
E3	<b>REIMAGINE</b> – add extra detail as a sentence to the part marked by * Use an editing flap.
✓✓	Any outstanding areas of writing will be acknowledged by a double tick next to it. At the end of the work a concise, positive comment will be written next to a double tick.
_____ sp	<b>Sometimes</b> your teacher may show you where to look for a spelling error by underlining the word or writing 'sp' in the margin. Correct this word underneath your work.

## Editing symbols used by pupils for improving writing.

^	To insert a <b>missing word</b> .
_____	To show a <b>spelling error</b> . Write the correct word underneath your work.
//	To show where a <b>new paragraph</b> should start.
_____ 	Draw a neat line through any mistakes with a <b>ruler and pencil</b> .
<b>Editing Flaps</b>	When you <b>rewrite</b> or <b>reimagine</b> a section of your work, glue an editing flap over the top of the sentence or paragraph you are improving and write improvements in purple pen.
